

REMINDER #3 – (Tuesday 17 July 2018)

Dear UMAT Candidate

UMAT2018 Admission Tickets were released on 11 July 2018. To collect your Admission Ticket please [log in to your account](#). Your username is the email address registered on your account. The Admission Ticket is your permission to attend the test centre and **MUST** be printed out and taken with you on the test day. Test centres will not accept electronic Admission Tickets.

Editing your identification details on your registration

Please [log in to your account](#), select *manage* your registration and then *edit* your registration details. Select the type of ID that you will take to the test centre from the list of approved identification documents in the drop-down box, and enter the identification expiry date. Your Admission Ticket will be updated automatically with the new details, please ensure to print your updated Admission Ticket.

After printing your Admission Ticket, please fill in your *identification document number* (e.g. passport number/ licence number) manually and sign your Admission Ticket so that it is ready to take on test day.

What to bring on test day

When you report to the test centre on 25 July 2018, you **MUST** bring your:

- [printed UMAT Admission Ticket](#);
- [current photo-bearing identification document](#); and
- pencils (medium soft HB), eraser and sharpener.

You may bring a clear bottle of drinking water into the test centre with you.

Clocks are provided in the test room. You may wear an **analogue wrist watch**, and **any alarm or stopwatch features must be switched off. Digital and smart watches are not permitted.**

Valuables such as wallets, keys and mobile phones may be placed under your desk during the test. Please note **mobile phones must be switched off** and placed face up under your desk/chair. **Mobile phones must not be worn on your body and must not be accessed until you have been dismissed from the test centre.**

All other items, including but not limited to calculators, pagers, stopwatches, audio or recording devices of any kind, MP3 players, digital watches, smart watches, activity trackers, earplugs, food, note paper, coloured pens/pencils, pencil cases, highlighters, and rulers are not permitted and their use will be considered an act of [misconduct](#).

There will be some space at the test centre to put your belongings. Only bring essential items, as neither the test centre nor the UMAT Office can be held responsible for their security.

Please note large spaces like test centres can be difficult to heat/cool. **To avoid being too cold or too hot, it is recommended to wear layers, which will allow you to adjust your own comfort level.**
