Dear UMAT Candidate

IDENTIFICATION

On the test day you will be required to show one form of photo-bearing identification.

Only these documents are acceptable:

- Current **passport**
- Current photo-bearing **driver's licence** (learner's permit, probationary or full licence)
- Current photo-bearing **Australian [Keypass](#)**
- Current photo-bearing **Australian [Proof of Age Card](#)**
- Current photo-bearing **New Zealand [18+ Card](#)**

PLEASE NOTE: If you do not possess a current passport or driver's licence you should apply for a Keypass, Proof of Age Card or 18+ Card.

Student ID cards, expired documents and/or photocopies of documents will NOT be accepted under any circumstances.

If you do not present one of the forms of acceptable ID listed above, or if the identity document you present does not bear an easily recognisable photograph of you as you look on the test day, you will not be permitted to sit UMAT and will be turned away from the test centre.

Adding your photograph and identification details to your registration

Admission Tickets will be released next week (approximately 2 weeks prior to the test date). In order to view the Admission Ticket, candidates must have uploaded their photograph and the details of their identification document to their registration.

To add your photograph and ID details to your registration, please [log in to your account](#) (username = registered email address), select to *manage* your registration and then *edit* your registration details. Click on *browse* to upload your photograph. To add your ID details, select the type of ID you will take to the test centre from the list of approved identification documents in the drop-down box, and enter the identification expiry date.
