

REMINDER #5 – (sent Monday 24 July 2017)

Dear UMAT Candidate

Please read the following information regarding the test day carefully.

- Arrive at the test centre at the arrival time given on your Admission Ticket. You must report to the session you have been allocated to; changes between sessions are not permitted.
- Food is not permitted in the test room unless you have been granted permission from our office for a medical condition. Have a meal before reporting to the test centre. There may be long queues to register at larger test centres; you may wish to bring a snack while you wait if you think you will be hungry.
- Water is permitted in a clear plastic bottle.
- It is advised that you dress in layers so you can adjust your clothing to the temperature of the test room.
- Your mobile phone must be switched off and placed in your bag or face up under your desk. The test supervisor at your centre will instruct you.
- You can wear a wristwatch (analogue). Alarm and stopwatch functions must be turned off during the test.
- Note paper is not permitted. Any rough work is to be done in the margins of your test booklet.
- You must follow the instructions of the test supervisors at your test centre at all times.
- UMAT is a 3 hour test and there will be an additional 10 minutes reading time at the beginning of the test. During the 10 minutes reading time you are only permitted to read and you are not permitted to write on, mark or fold your test booklet or answer sheet.
- You are not permitted to go to the bathroom during the reading time or in the last 15 minutes of the test.
- Answers must be marked directly on the answer sheet, not in the test booklet. Answers inadvertently recorded in the test booklet will not be marked.

- If you have any issues on the test day, please raise your hand and bring the issue to the attention of a test supervisor so that it can be addressed **immediately**.
- Candidates are not permitted to leave the test centre before the testing time has elapsed and candidates have been dismissed by the test supervisor.
- You should allow up to 5 hours from the arrival time on your Admission Ticket for all testing procedures to be completed. This includes registration processes and testing time. This time may be shorter at regional test centres.
