

UMAT Results Information

Your Overall UMAT Score is calculated using the following formula:

$$\text{Overall Score} = \text{Score 1} + \text{Score 2} + \text{Score 3}$$

Please note: The Overall Score is calculated to several decimal places and then rounded. **The Overall Score is calculated before the rounding of section scores. It is not possible for candidates to replicate this process.**

Example 1:

Score 1 = 50.55 - reported on your Statement of Results as 51

Score 2 = 50.55 - reported on your Statement of Results as 51

Score 3 = 50.55 - reported on your Statement of Results as 51

If you attempt to calculate your Overall Score you will get an aggregate of 153, but your Overall Score is calculated as $50.55 + 50.55 + 50.55 = 151.65$

Your Overall Score is therefore reported on you Statement of Results as 152

Example 2:

Score 1 = 50.40 - reported on your Statement of Results as 50

Score 2 = 50.40 - reported on your Statement of Results as 50

Score 3 = 50.40 - reported on your Statement of Results as 50

If you attempt to calculate your Overall Score you will get an aggregate of 150, but your Overall Score is calculated as $50.40 + 50.40 + 50.40 = 151.20$

Your Overall Score is therefore reported on you Statement of Results as 151
